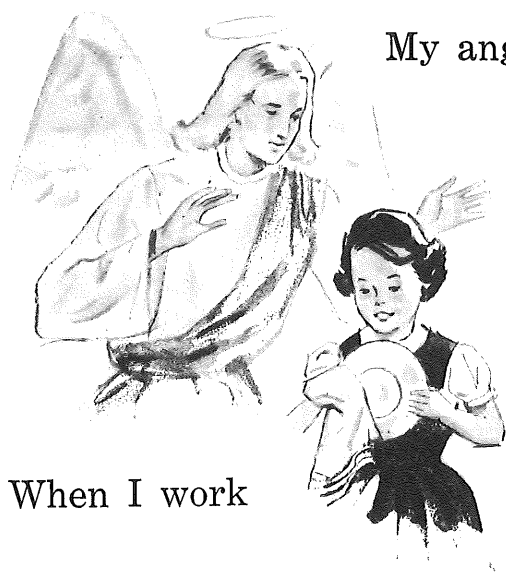


Guardian Angel

A little child like me.

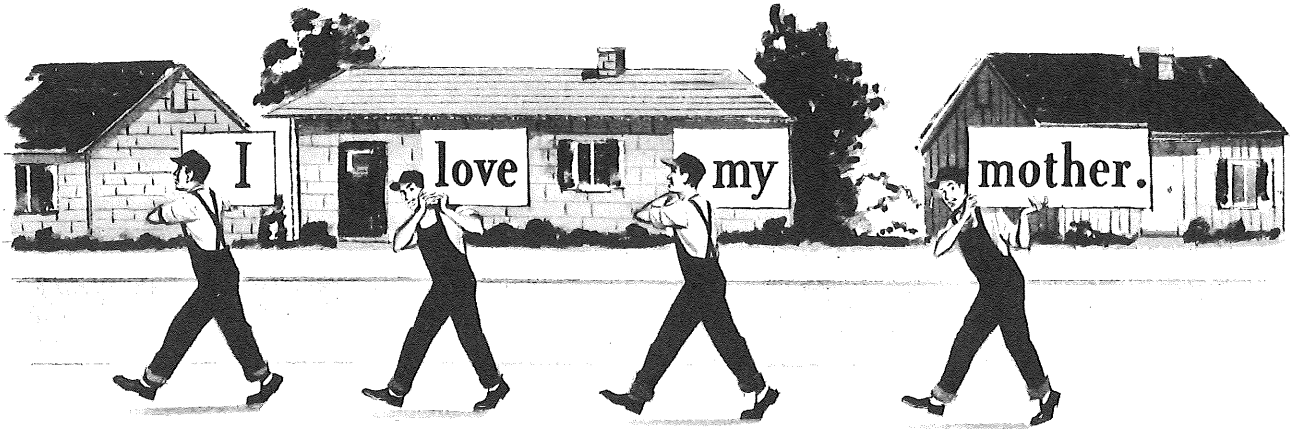

These words are working together to build a complete thought. A complete thought is called a **sentence**.

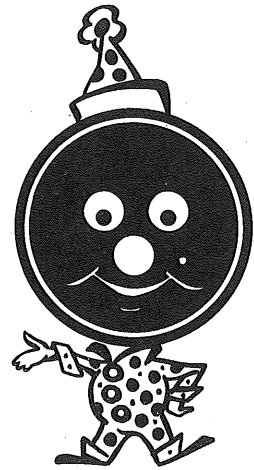
Make each group of words a sentence by drawing a line to the right word.

Black Button

This sentence tells something. It tells that God made us. A sentence that tells something is called a **telling sentence**.

Black Button is a **period**. A period is always used at the end of a telling sentence.
