*Seventh Grade Religion Lesson Plans*

RELIGION-7th GRADE – REVISED 2011

Introduction – Beginning the school year 2011, Book 7 of the “Living My Religion Series”, **Living for Triumph**, will be implemented. Parent/Tutor – please take a few minutes to read pages v and vi of the text to become familiar with the theme of this book. The student will be reading the lessons, memorizing answers to some questions and sending written answers in to the school for the Unit Tests. There are “Questions for Class Discussion”, “Points to Remember”, and “Questions for Thoughtful Students” throughout the lessons. These are not assigned, but it would be advantageous to read over the questions and information contained under these titles. In this book, the Baltimore Catechism questions are not taught in numerical order, however, the questions are in numerical order in the back of the book, pages 272 – 306.

There is also a **Syllabus and Teacher’s Manual** to accompany the book. The parent/tutor and student should take a few minutes to read through the contents and pages 1 through 10 to become familiar with what is to be accomplished this year. There are activities in the **Syllabus and Teacher’s Manual** which will not be assigned on the lesson plans. Use your discretion regarding additional assignments.

Each student should say the daily rosary as part of their school day. The rosary contains most of the essential prayers of the Church and it can set the religious tone of the school day. The daily rosary can be split into three parts and be said at the beginning, middle, and end of the day, if that is more convenient, or the family can do the rosary together in the evening.

On Fridays, the Stations of the Cross should be said.

Students who attended OLVS Home Study Program (HSP) last year should know the Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, and the Apostles’ Creed. If your child does not know these prayers by heart, use the first two weeks to memorize them. These prayers can be found on pages 307-310 in **Living for Triumph**.

In addition to studying **Living for Triumph**, your child will study the Old Testament **Bible History** by Ignatius Schuster, D.D. and will read from the Old Testament and the New Testament.

The study of the Catholic Faith is one of the important cornerstones of our educational program and it should not take second place to any other subject. Please stress the importance of learning the Faith as it may apply to your child’s adult life. This will allow you to stress some particular points that have affected your adult life and your faith.
